Ballet Arts is planning to hold summer classes on a limited basis for 7 weeks beginning July 6 through August 20. Classes will be held Monday through Thursday. A schedule of the classes offered is attached. For safety we are limiting the enrollment to a maximum of 12 students per class. Due to the limited enrollment we will give first priority to students signing up for the full seven week program.

We will take registration for the full program through June 30. After that time if there is space available we will open it up to those who want fewer weeks. If there is a large group of students who cannot fit into the initial offering, we will consider adding classes. At this time we are offering classes for Ballet Levels 2 through Advanced. If you have a younger dancer, those in the combo classes or Ballet Level 1, and are interested in summer classes. Please send us an email and let us know your needs. We will consider adding classes for you starting at a later date.

Attached are a registration form and Covid-19 consent form. Payment should be made through auto pay. If you have paid tuition this way in the past you just need to let us know that your information is the same. If you have not made payments this way you should also fill out the ACH form attached. Tuition rates are listed at the bottom of the summer schedule. If you have been sending tuition through automatic payment through your bank, that is also acceptable. You may scan the necessary documents and email them to robin@balletarts.org, mail them to the studio, or place them in an envelope and drop them off at the mail slot in the office #103.

Before classes begin, we are taking precautions to make participating in classes as safe as possible. We will be deep cleaning the studio and provide a hand sanitizing station. We realize that dancing wearing masks would be difficult, however dancers may wear masks in class if they choose to do so. There are 15 minutes between classes to allow us to sanitize the barres for the second class.

Students will need to be dropped off, dressed for class. At this time we ask no dance bags be carried into the studio. Dancers will leave their street shoes in a designated space and carry their ballet slippers into the studio to put on before class begins. The lobby area will not be available for parents to wait for their dancers. We feel it is best to limit the number of people in the studio to teachers and dancers. Students must be picked up on time following class.

If you need to buy tights or ballet shoes, the store will be open allowing one customer at a time in the store.

We realize these rules are restricting but believe they are necessary to keep everyone as safe as possible. If you have questions or concerns please feel free to call. The studio phone is a cell phone and I can answer it from home. 805 495-7940.
